

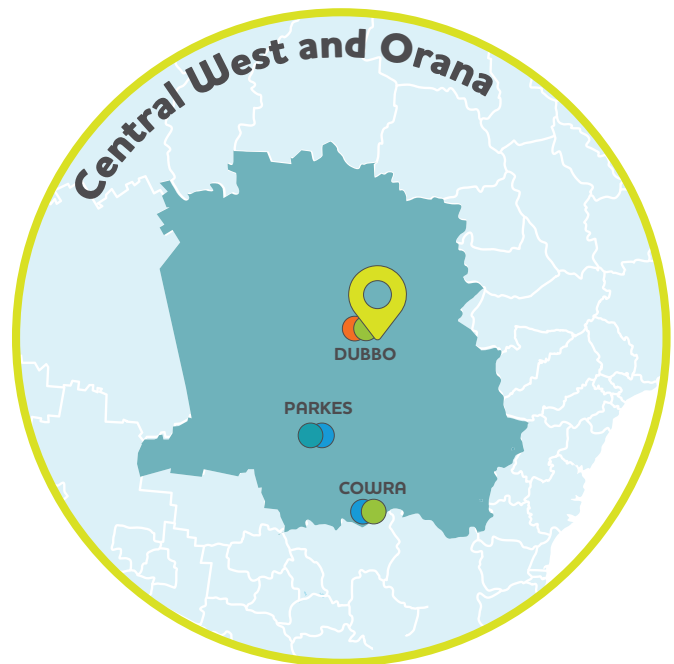
BaptistCare Services in the Central West
