Dear Family Members and Carers,

I am pleased to inform you we are making changes to residents attending family gatherings.

As of **Monday, 18 October 2021**, restrictions have been updated in the following homes:

- Carey Gardens
- Griffith Centre

Visitors to the home

- Two visitors per day per resident, provided they are over 12 years of age and double vaccinated for at least 14 days;
- Two unvaccinated people may visit for end-of-life reasons only;
- Health professionals providing a service to a resident don't count as visitors;
- Travellers from COVID-19 affected areas require an exemption to enter the ACT;
- All visitors must wear a surgical mask while indoors and follow COVIDSafe behaviour;
- Visits may take place in a resident's room or an outdoor area.

Residents attending offsite family gatherings or excursions

- Residents can attend family gatherings that abide by the current Public Health Order;
- Residents who are partially or fully unvaccinated should only leave to attend small family gatherings.

Please read the information provided in previous letters about taking your loved one on an excursion, and ensure their health and wellbeing is a priority.
