Dear Family Members and Carers,

I am writing to let you know that the Stay At Home order for regional NSW has been extended until at least 12:01am on Saturday, 28 August 2021.

Restrictions to visiting have not changed and are listed below:

- Homes are closed to visitors until at least 12:01am on Saturday, 28 August 2021;
- Residents are not allowed to leave their aged care home except for essential circumstances such as medical appointments;
- Residents do not need to wear a facemask inside the home; and
- Residents must wear a surgical facemask if they leave the home.

Any resident who wishes to wear a surgical facemask during this time will be provided one by BaptistCare.

To arrange a visit under exceptional circumstances or compassionate reasons, please speak to your Residential Manager.

We will update you as NSW Health releases new information. If you have any questions or concerns about these restrictions, please don't hesitate to speak to your Residential Manager.
