Dear Family Members and Carers,

Following the **new Stay At Home orders issued by NSW Health on Saturday, 26 June**, I am writing to update you on more changes to visitation requirements for BaptistCare aged care homes in regional NSW.

These restrictions affect the following homes:

- Maranoa Centre
- Kularoo
- Warabrook Centre
- Mid-Richmond
- Bethshan Gardens
- Niola
- Caloola
- George Forbes House

As a result of the **new Stay-at-Home orders** from NSW Health, the following additional restrictions are in place for the rest of NSW:

- All visitors and staff must wear a surgical facemask inside the home.
- Only two visitors per resident are allowed each day.
- Visits should take place in the resident's room.
- Visitors who have been to any part of the Greater Sydney region including Sydney, the Central Coast, Illawarra and Blue Mountains in the last 14 days are excluded from visiting the home for a minimum of 14 days after leaving the area.

The restrictions below remain in place:

- Visitors who have been have been to any [close, casual or monitor for symptoms locations](#) in NSW in the last 14 days are excluded from visiting.
- Visitors who have been to interstate or overseas.
- One person per 4sqm inside the home.

We will continue to update you as NSW Health releases new information. If you have any questions or concerns about these new restrictions, please don't hesitate to speak to your Residential Manager.
